#### **Introduction:**

Among the most significant roles undertaken by INP is providing consultation services to decision-makers, international organizations, academic community, private sector and civil society inside and outside Egypt. The Institute has succeeded in providing the required consultations to the United Nations agencies such as United Nations Development Program, International Organization for Migration, Food and Agriculture Organization, International Labor Organization, and Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia.

INP also provided the scientific academies with scientific consultations, for instance: the International Institute for Development Economics Research, the United Nations University and the International Peace Research Association. International donor agencies have also been beneficiaries of the Institute's advisory services such as USAID, AFDB and Fredrich Naumen as well as decision-makers outside Egypt in the Arab world such as Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, Qatar, Syria, Palestine and Lebanon. The Institute provided advisory services to some civil society organizations inside and outside Egypt to enable them upgrade their performance. This guide lists the main fields of consulting services provided by INP, which highlights the Institute's peculiarity in terms of being multidisciplinary which can benefit various work areas.

INP carries out consultations upon the request of many national institutions and within the framework of the contract between both parties. Among these institutions, for example, the Ministry of Planning, Energy Planning Agency, the Integrated Development consultants, the Organization For Reconstruction & Development Of The Egyptian Village, the Academy of Scientific Research, Ministry of Public Business Sector, Experimental center to assess Social Projects, Middle Egypt Flour Mills, and General Authority For reconstruction projects and agricultural development, Social Fund for Development, Environmental Affairs Agency, Ministry of Local Development, and the Ministry of Irrigation and Water Resources.

There are also research and studies are being carried out in accordance with the request of regional and international institutions, such as, United Nations Development Program, United Nations World Food Program, United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA), World Bank, and Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the United Nations Industrial Development Organization, the United Nations International Labor Organization and the German Agency for Technical Cooperation GTZ.

The guide is divided into three parts: the first part presents the consulting expertise of INP, the second part introduces a list of the institute's experts, scientific disciplines and areas of interest, and the third part presents the latest consultations carried out by the institute during the period 2018-2021.
